R-08 Modular S-Curve Bench, designed for an intervention project, offers various configurations that can serve different functions and/or atmospheres. Situated next to a 20-foot, free-standing wall devoted to the client's immense art collection, the modularity of the bench supplies the needed flexibility to contrast/compliment the feature wall and the entertainment space. The upholstery is rendered in a colour selected by the client, enhancing its presence in a space despite its impermanence. The base is made of laminated plywood with the same stain as the floor, allowing all compositions to sit naturally.
